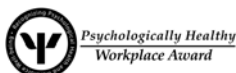
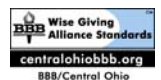
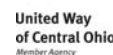

Jewish Family Services Career and Workforce Development Staff assist clients to obtain Employment

In the FY 2007 year, Jewish Family Services completed the intake and assessment process and provided services to approximately 610 individuals through the Career and Workforce Development Department.

55% (337) of these individuals obtained employment with an average hourly wage of \$12.66 per hour.

80% of the individuals who obtained employment were seeking entry level employment and the average wage these individuals received is \$9.45/hour or approximately \$19,635 annually.

20% of the individuals who obtained employment were seeking professional positions with salaries above \$30,000 annually. The average wage obtained by these individuals is \$32.25 per hour or approximately \$67,080 annually.
